RDA declares four housing schemes illegal on Chakri road, Rwp

RAWALPINDI, August 30, 2018: Rawalpindi Development Authority (RDA) has declared four housing schemes illegal i.e. CPEC Resort, Abdullah City, Khanian Homes and Bin Alam City on Chakri road, Rawalpindi and directed owners to stop illegal advertisements and developments. Jamshaid Aftab, Director Metropolitan Planning and Traffic Engineering (MP&TE), RDA declared illegal / unauthorized advertisements by above mentioned four illegal housing schemes. RDA under section Punjab Private Housing schemes and Land Subdivision Rules 2010 issued notices to owners of four illegal housing schemes namely Mr. Imran Siddique , owner of CPEC Resort Housing Scheme, Mr. Asim Aziz, owner of Abdullah City, Mr. Tajamal Hussain, owner of Khanian Homes and Mr. Qazim Alam, owner of Bin Alam City Chakri road, Rawalpindi. The notice warned them to stop immediately the advertisements otherwise RDA would seal the site offices of the illegal housing schemes in Rawalpindi. RDA advises general public in their own interest that they should not make any investment in any illegal / unauthorized Housing Scheme which status declared illegal by RDA. Otherwise, they themselves are responsible for their losses. Director (MP&TE), RDA also requested Islamabad Electric Supply Company (IESCO), Sui Northern Gas Pipelines Ltd (SNGPL) and PTCL, not to extend services to these illegal housing schemes as its status is un-approved / illegal. RDA spokesman Hafiz Muhammad Irfan said the Director General (DG) RDA, Rana Akbar Hayat has directed the MP&TE Directorate to take strict action against illegal / unauthorized commercial and residential construction activities, booking offices and encroachments without any fear or favour.
